<b>CIEH Award in Environmental Management L3 4 days</b>	Pre-requisites:	None, although CIEH L2 is recommended
<b>Course Aims</b> Four day course for those with responsibilities within an environmental management system (such as ISO 14001). All organisations have a legal responsibility for the impact that they may have on the environment. This qualification focuses specifically on the practical issues associated with implementing an environmental management system.
