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IOSH Managing Safely 4-5 day	Pre requisite:	None
<p>This 4 or 5 day course is intended to provide delegates with the basic skills and knowledge to help them manage health and safety in the workplace.</p> <p>During the course delegates will study a practical programme, full of step-by-step guidance, and with a sharp business focus. They will also find that the highly innovative format and content engages and inspires them – a critical factor in getting the essential health and safety messages across.</p> <p>Who is the Course For? Supervisors & Managers</p> <p>Learning Outcomes</p> <p>At the end of the course delegates will have a clear understanding of the following key points:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Introducing managing safely - The first module makes it clear that managers are accountable for their teams, and makes a persuasive case for managing safely.2. Assessing risks - This module defines and demystifies 'risk' and 'risk assessment'. Simple scoring systems are introduced, and delegates carry out a series of assessments.3. Controlling risks - This session tackles cutting risks down, concentrating on the best techniques to control key risks, and how to choose the right method.4. Understanding your responsibilities - This module looks at the demands of the law and how the legal system works, and introduces a health and safety management systems.5. Identifying hazards - All the main issues any operation has to deal with are covered in this module – entrances and exits, work traffic, fire, chemicals, electricity, physical and verbal abuse, bullying, stress, noise, housekeeping and the working environment, slips, trips and falls, working at height, computers and manual handling.6. Investigating accidents and incidents - The session starts with why accidents should be investigated, and goes on to cover why things go wrong, and how to carry out an investigation when they do.7. Measuring performance - This module explains how checking performance can help to improve health and safety. Delegates learn how to develop basic performance indicators, and get to grips with auditing and proactive and reactive measuring.8. Protecting our environment - A short but effective introduction to waste and pollution leads into a look at how organisations and individual managers can get involved in cutting down environmental impacts. <p>Assessment</p> <p>Delegates are required to complete a work based project as well as a written end examination.</p>
