COSHH – Supervision & Control 1/2 day	Pre-requisite: COSHH in Construction – The Hazards
<p><b>Course Aims</b></p> <p>This half day course is intended to provide supervisors or managers with an understanding of the ways they should manage COSHH hazards and risks associated with their site. During the course delegates will reach a clear understanding of the ways in which chemical risks are controlled.</p>	
<p><b>Course Delivery</b></p> <p>Where possible the course leader will use COSHH assessment systems and forms adopted by the client and in so doing reinforce their value and availability to delegates.</p>

<p><b>Introduction</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Overview of the course: The course is split into two halves; the first half addresses the SHH (Substances Hazardous to Health) in COSHH, the second addresses the C (Control).</li> <li>• The need to manage exposure to hazardous substances</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Risk control</b></p> <p>The risk control section is designed to address the eight principles of risk control specified in COSHH 2004.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Designing and operate to minimise emission.</li> <li>• Controls take into account routes of exposure.</li> <li>• Control measures proportionate to the health risk.</li> <li>• Choose the most effective and reliable control options.</li> <li>• Augment with PPE where required.</li> <li>• Ensure that the introduction of control measures does not increase the overall risk to health and safety.</li> <li>• Inform and train employees on the hazards, risks &amp; control measures developed to minimise the risks.</li> <li>• Check and review regularly all elements of control measures for their continuing effectiveness.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>End test</b></p> <p>The course will conclude with a short end test, designed to confirm understanding of the key learning points.</p>
